We want you all to know that each year Camp Vaudeville has a specific theme and this year it is **“The Sidewalks of New York”**. **Dates:** Camp Starts on July 8, ends on July 16. (No camp on Saturday or Sunday.)

**Final Performance:** Tuesday, July 16 at 7:00 PM

**Camp Time:** 8:30 AM until 12:30 PM. Please be prompt! Being on time is a great life lesson for all children!

**Camp attire:** Comfortable play clothes. **SHOES THAT TIE!! No flip flops or sandals.**

**Performance attire:**     **Boys** wear black slacks, black soft shoes and socks.  
                                  **Girls** – a black leotard, black tights (NOT panty hose) and black shorts.  
                                  Keds-type black tennis shoes or jazz shoes.  
                                  **Boys and Girls** – Wear their Camp T-shirts to complete their “costume”.  
                                  **Do not wait** to find these black shoes. Do it now.

**Drop off and pick up:** Come down 5<sup>th</sup> Street, pass the Smoot and immediately turn right into the Trinity Episcopal parking lot. Drop campers so they will enter through the gated iron fence at the back of the Theatre. (There will be signage.) Then just please circle out of that lot onto Juliana Street. If all follow these instructions, we won’t have a traffic jam in the parking lot!

**Field Trip on Thursday, July 11** at approximately 6 PM. We will have dinner, a tour and entertainment in one of our beautiful and historic buildings on Market Street. Details will follow. There **MAY** be enough space for parents to attend also, but we’re not sure yet. There is no charge for the campers’ field trip.
